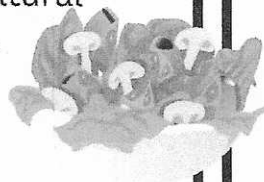
Hibernation & Migration

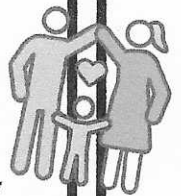
