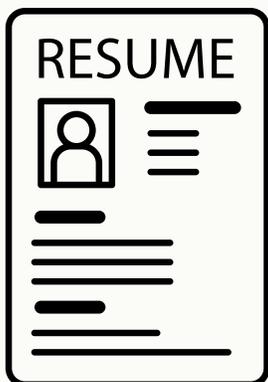

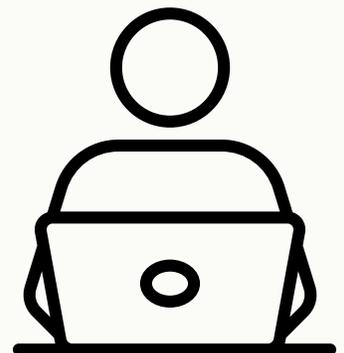

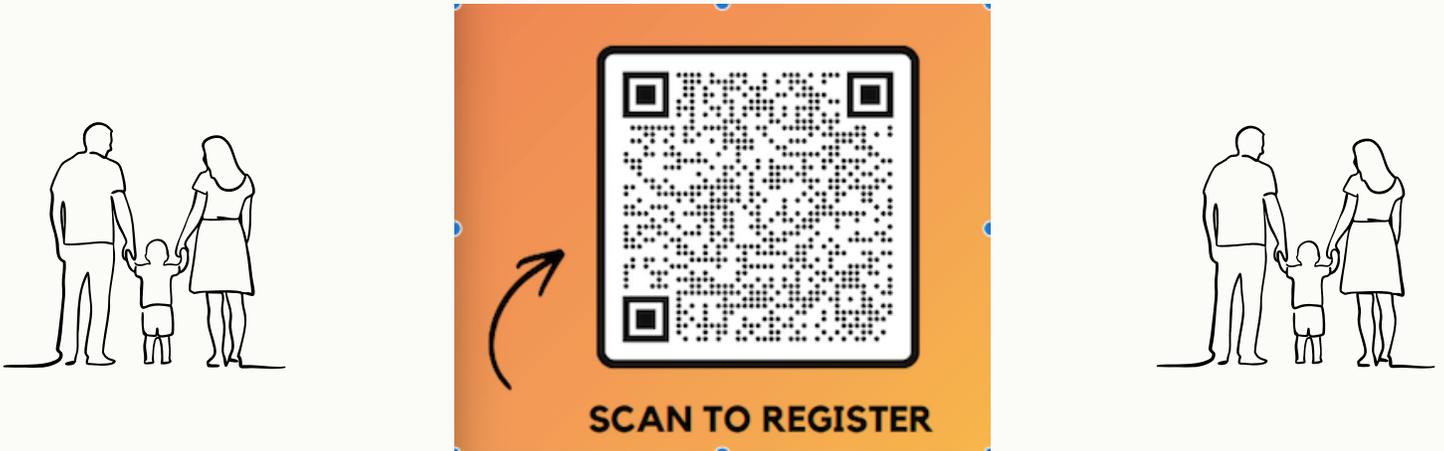

# Help Teachers, Help YOU!

Families are an essential part of early learning—your insight helps teachers plan better experiences for your child.

Here are some simple ways to partner with your child’s caregiver or teacher:

## **#1: Share Information:**

Let teachers know about your child’s interests, routines, new skills, or challenges at home.

## **#2: Ask Questions:**

If you see a lesson plan posted, ask how activities support learning or how you can extend them at home.

## **#3: Support Routines:**

Consistent routines between home and school (like bedtime, mealtime, or self-help skills) help children feel secure.

## **#4: Stay Connected:**

Read newsletters, classroom notes, or messages so you know what your child is working on.

## **#5: Celebrate Growth:**

Talk with your child about what they did during the day and celebrate effort—not just outcomes.
